

## 10th Manlleu Short Film Festival

From the 29<sup>th</sup> of may to the 5<sup>th</sup> of June 2012

### Rules and Regulations

- Any fiction films that do not exceed 30 minutes and were produced after January 1, 2010 can be submitted, except for those with advertising purposes.
- Worldwide short films will be accepted, as long as they are submitted along with a format Word list that includes the time code and film dialogues in Catalan, Spanish or English.
- All shooting formats will be accepted and included in one of the following categories: Film, Video, Animation and Documentary.
- Short films in competition will be eligible for the following awards:
  - Best Movie: 3.000 euros.
  - Best Video Short Film: 600 euros.
  - Best Osona Short Film: 300 euros.
  - Best Documentary: 300 euros.
  - Audience Award for the best movie: 300 euros.
- Only short films in which some member of the crew was born and/or is resident in the shire of Osona (Barcelona, Catalonia) will be eligible for the Best Osona Short Film.
- Films must be submitted online at [www.shortfilmdepot.com](http://www.shortfilmdepot.com), and a copy of the film must be sent in DVD PAL format inside a case that must be labeled with the title of the short and the author's name, as well as any required documents to the following address:

- Submission deadline is December 1, 2011.
- Screening reels of selected films must have been delivered to the festival organization before May 22, 2012. Again, the case must be labeled with the title of the film, the director's name and the wording "No commercial value. Only for cultural purposes".
- Reception of materials and selection of short films will be notified at the festival's website (<http://www.manlleufilmfestival.com>).

- All received DVD copies will be part of the Manlleu City Council archives. The organization of the festival can use those films to be screened in cultural meetings, with no commercial purposes.
- The awarded films will be exhibited in a festival special show on the Local Television 9TV.
- A DVD copy containing all awarded films will be handed in to the members of the collaborating association "Friends of the Festival".
- The members of the jury come from the culture and film creation world; their decision being indisputable and having the authority to declare any of the above-mentioned awarded categories void. Another committee will have selected the pieces that will eventually be screened during the Festival and which will consequently be eligible to the awards, following their own criteria.
- Awarded authors or their delegates will pick up the prize personally at the Awards Ceremony. If neither of them can attend the event, the Festival's organization must be informed in advance.
- The expenses for the return of the 35mm exhibit copies are met by the organization of the Festival. The copies will be sent to the shipping address.
- The organization will not be held responsible for loss or damage of the copies once delivered to the forwarding company.
- The Festival's organization might have to modify any of the regulations contained in this document if required. Taking part in this Festival involves the acceptance of all these regulations. The non compliance of any of the above can lead to the withdrawal of the film from the competition.
